YKSD is currently soliciting proposals for a Nutrition Science instructor for our school sites. The instruction should cover various topics, including but not limited to: Nutrition science and Indigenous foods, Food preservation and medicine, Beginning Herbology and wildcrafting, Traditional Healing, and Alaskan Gardening.

Objective: The objective of this program is to provide students with comprehensive instruction in Nutrition Science, focusing on the importance of Indigenous foods, food preservation, herbal medicine, traditional healing practices, and Alaskan gardening. The program aims to enhance students' knowledge and appreciation of nutrition and its connection to culture, health, and sustainable living.

We are requesting one or more 5-day intensive workshops to be offered at 1 up to 10 of our remote schools, providing instruction on basic nutrition science.

The proposals must include the following elements:

- A. An all-inclusive cost per student, including supply costs.
- B. Description of the training, including the topics to be covered and instructional approach.
- C. A minimum of five days of training, with a detailed daily schedule.
- D. Room and board costs.
- E. Transportation costs.
